

## Innovation Projects

### C&W Low Carbon Programme



This project will offer a coherent package of support that will enhance the energy and resource efficiency of Coventry & Warwickshire SMEs, support local SMEs to diversify into the low carbon economy and enable the development of new low carbon products through supporting SMEs to develop and adopt new low carbon technologies.

The project led by Coventry City Council will promote Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Use within SMEs through one to one diagnostic support, workshops and providing revenue grants to invest in low carbon technologies and reduce energy usage. The grants are available for the development and market testing of new to market products and technologies, diversification from existing products and the development of low carbon versions. Coaching and mentoring and workshops (topics such as BIM software) to support the commercialisation of new products will also be provided.

The project will support 75 SMEs to promote Research, Innovation and the Adoption of Low Carbon Technologies in small businesses.

### Focus Digital



This innovation project will support the acceleration to market and/or internal implementation of new products, services and process within the digital media/ICT domain by SMEs in Coventry and Warwickshire, Birmingham and Solihull, Black Country and The Marches.

It will provide support to SMEs through a combination of workshops (e.g. social media, web optimisation), development support, usability studies and capital and revenue grants.

The project will help 160 enterprises to engage and invest in innovation after provision of technical expertise and knowledge, to allow SMEs to take the next step in product development.

Capital grants are available to cover costs of tooling and machinery needed to develop your new product.

## Innovative Coventry and Warwickshire



This project will ensure that the benefits of innovation and new technology are felt in the local economy of Coventry and Warwickshire. The area's urban and rural centres will be used as test-beds for emerging technologies in the fields of data capture, energy usage, IT connectivity, smart systems, digital technology and health and assistive technologies.

The project is led by Coventry City Council and will provide a range of usability solutions for SMEs with products in the development cycle including user focus groups, interviews and questionnaires, co-creation sessions, usability walkthroughs, expert appraisals and end user panel reviews and workshops providing information on testing.

The project aims to encourage collaboration between the knowledge base, innovative businesses and local authorities, and support 75 SMEs to develop, test and market new products.

## Proof of Concept



Proof of Concept is a grant scheme offering grants of up to £4,000 to SMEs who are considering the viability of new products.

This support aims to help determine and shape the commercial potential and routes to market of innovative new ideas through proof of concept activity. Ensuring that you focus your research, design and innovation resources on viable ideas helps to increase the likelihood and decrease the timescales involved in bringing innovative new products and processes to market.

Support is offered through grants to SMEs based in Coventry and Warwickshire to enable structured proof of concept activity to be carried out covering external costs relating to IP due diligence and protection, market research / analysis / assessment, business plan and prototype development related to an innovative new product or process.

## Technology Start-up



This business support initiative provides entrepreneurs who have a technological or knowledge based business idea, with free consultancy support to get them registered as a new legal entity and provides a firm foundation from which to grow and develop their new company.

The project will provide 1:1 coaching and mentoring which will be delivered alongside a series of workshops & seminars on various business related topics such as strategy development, business planning, finance, sales & marketing, market knowledge, social media and LinkedIn.

It will support 60 new business start-ups, assist 100 potential entrepreneurs to be enterprise ready and link beneficiaries to incubation facilities & support at the Technology Park.
